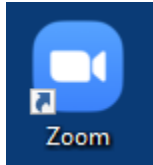


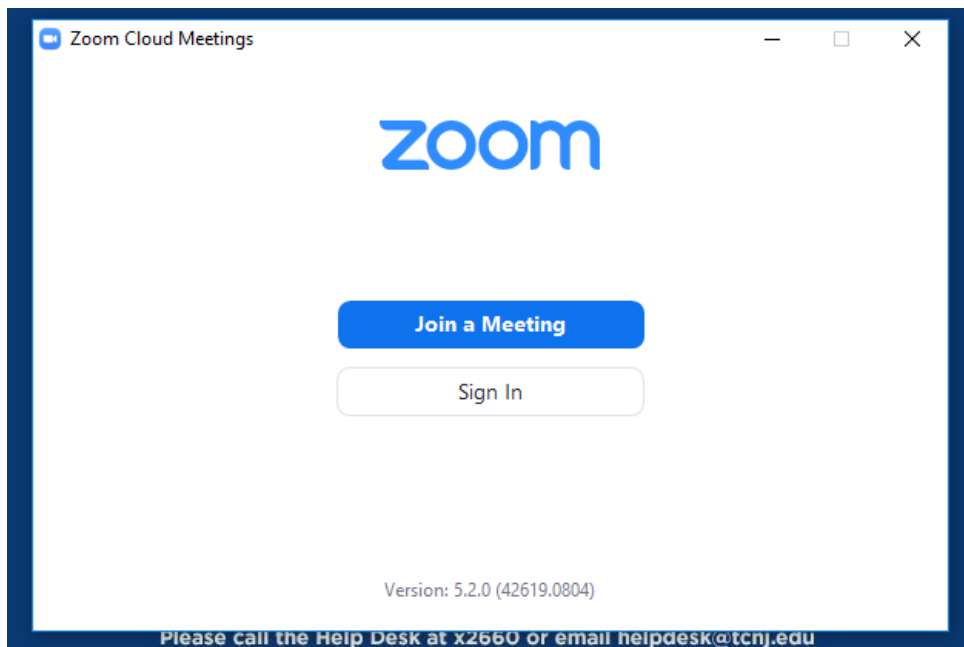
How To Sign In To TCNJ Zoom from the Zoom Icon

There are many ways you can sign in to Zoom, and none of them are “wrong,” provided that it gets you in to your meeting and where you want to go. These instructions are specifically for Windows PCs with the Zoom application installed and on the desktop.

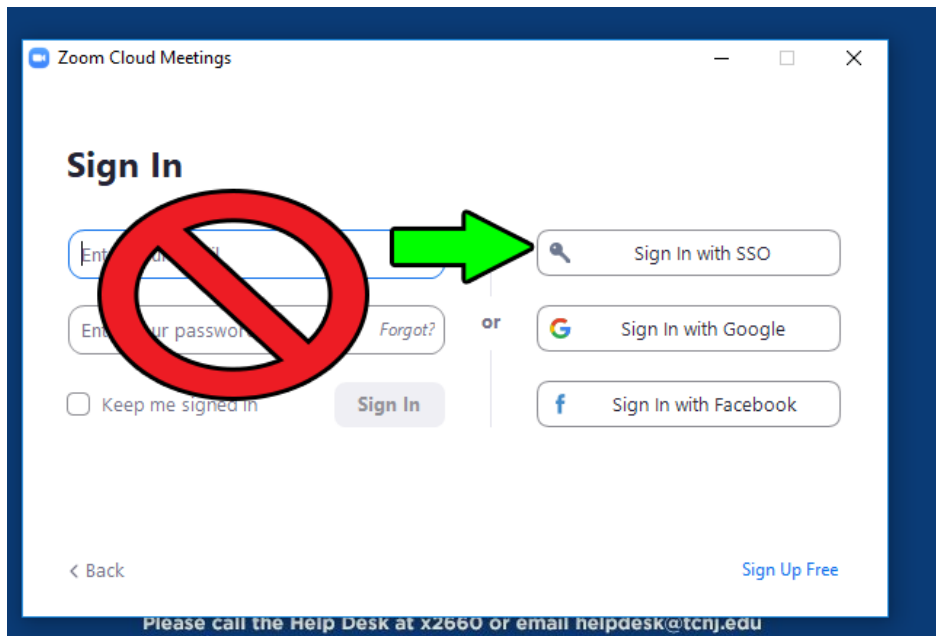
Locate the Zoom icon, and double click it.



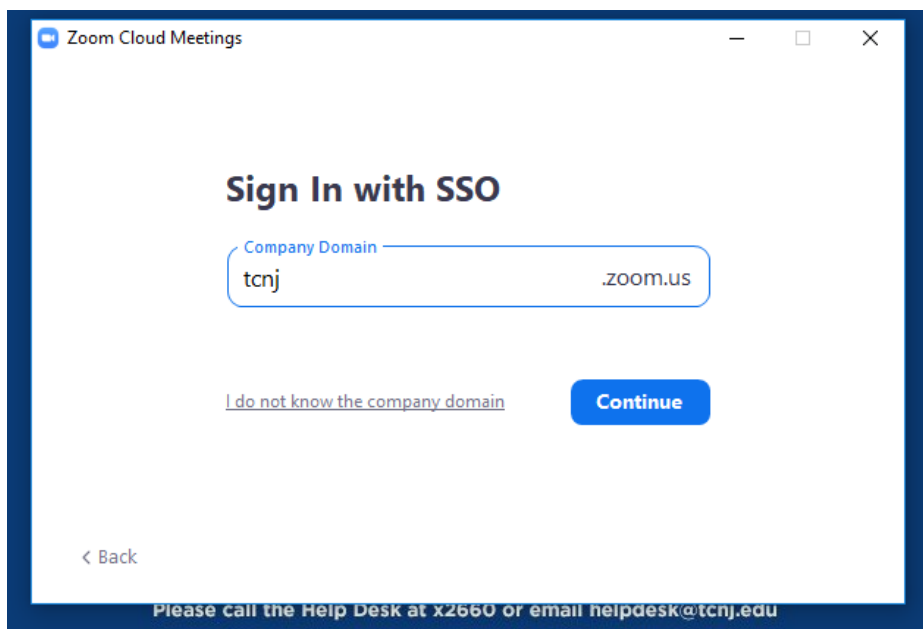
Once you double click it, it will open up the application, and give you two choices: “Sign In” and “Join a Meeting”. If you select join a meeting, you can enter in a meeting number and join as a guest. To sign in to your Zoom account, select “Sign In”.



After selecting “Sign In” you will be taken to a log in box. At that point, you will be given the opportunity to enter a username and password, or use various services to sign in. Do not type your TCNJ username and password into this box, instead, select the “Sign in With SSO” button.



When you click “Sign in with SSO”, another prompt will ask you for your SSO Domain. Fill in the blank space with “TCNJ” (not case sensitive)



After clicking the continue button, a browser window will open up with the familiar TCNJ SSO Sign-on page. Enter your TCNJ username (no @tcnj.edu) and password. The browser may ask you to allow permission to download and/or run a program. You should allow this. You will now be signed in to Zoom.
